- * Develops infection control training modules;
- * Defines the goal, objectives and priorities for all surveillance activities on healthcare-associated infections, including time frame areas, patient population to be studied and surveillance method to be used.

As such, the ICC shall meet regularly at least quarterly and as needed with adequate documentation [outbreaks of infection in the health care facility or from the community].

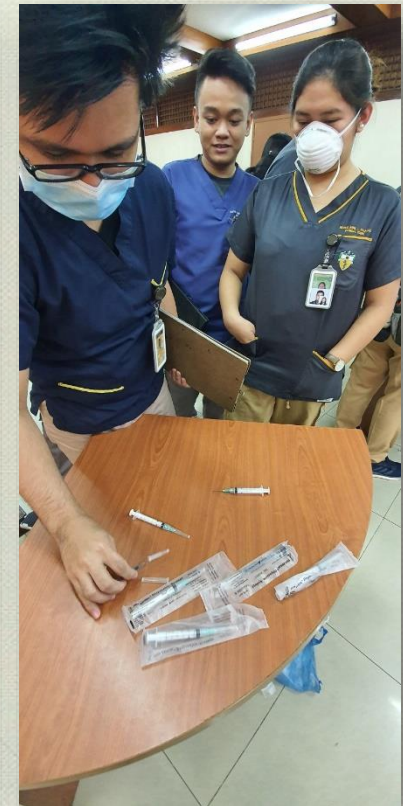

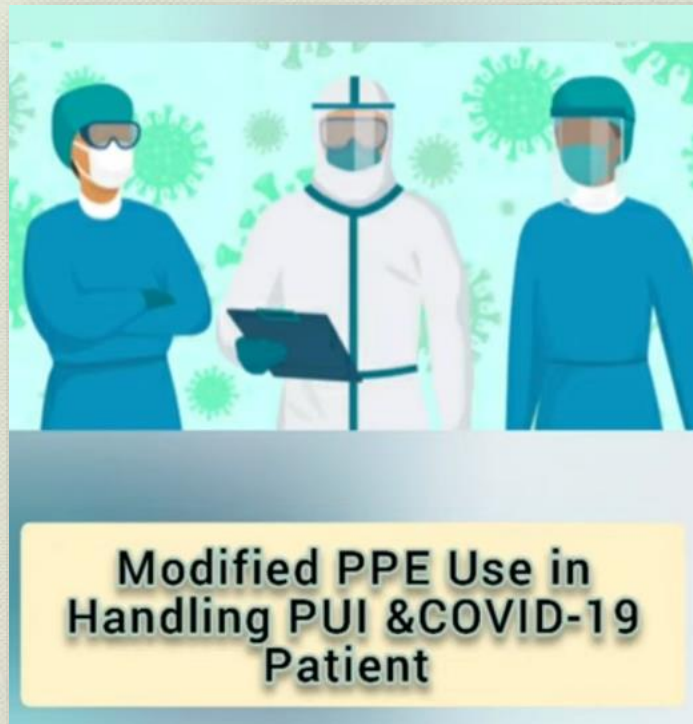

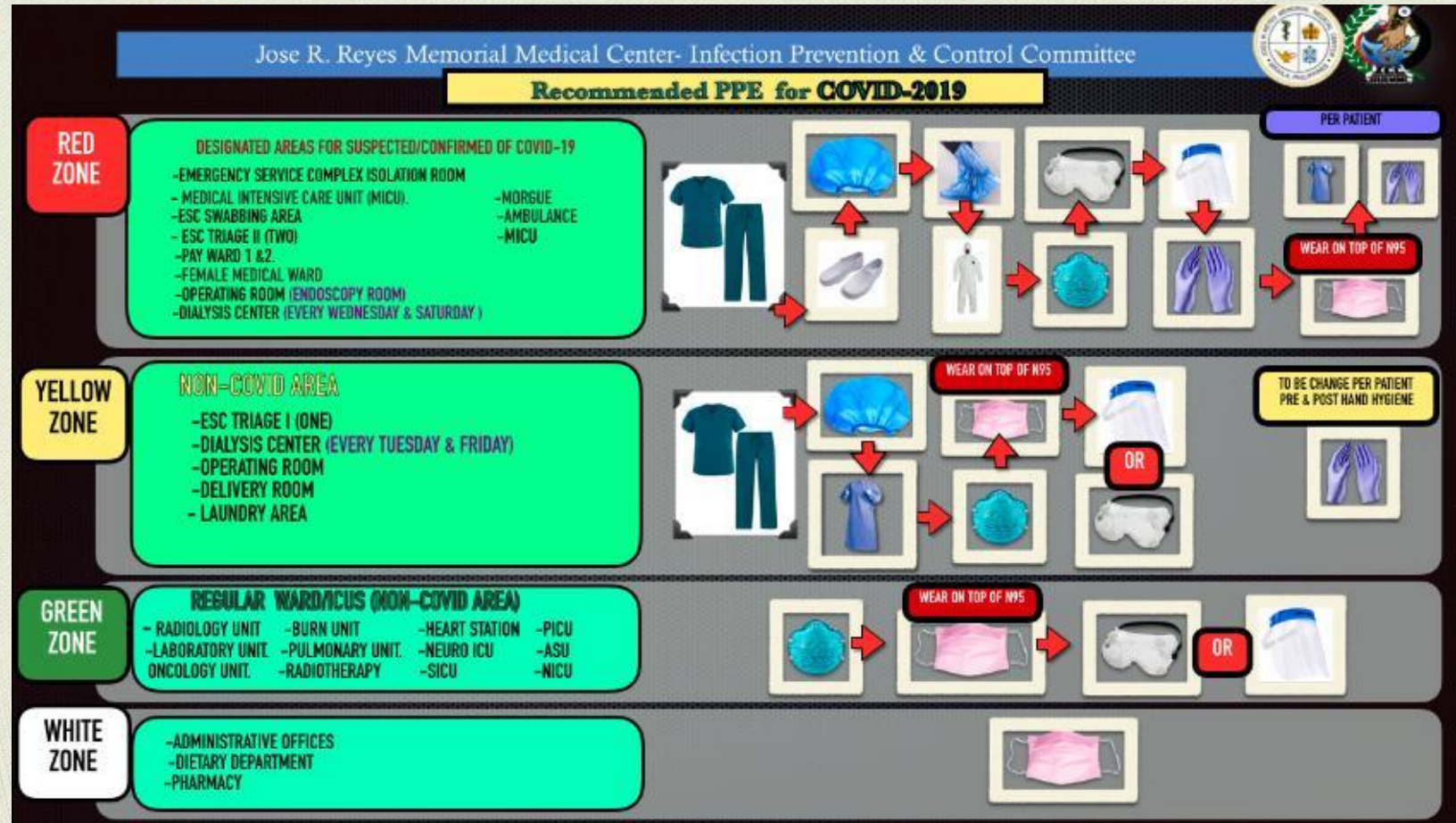

Response to COVID-19: PPE Modification due to Scarcity of Supply

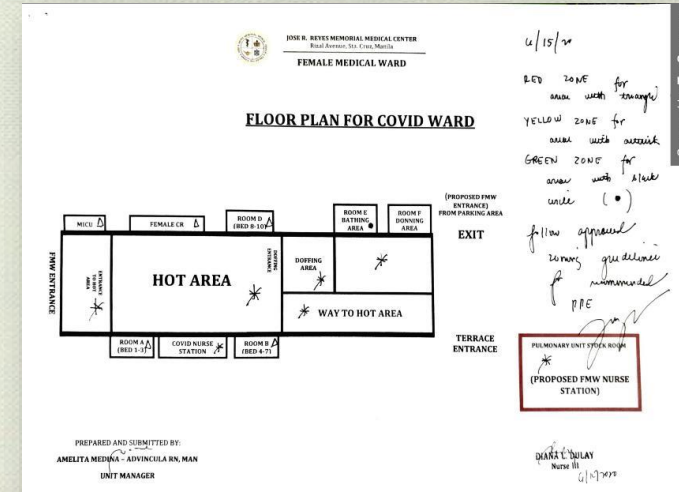
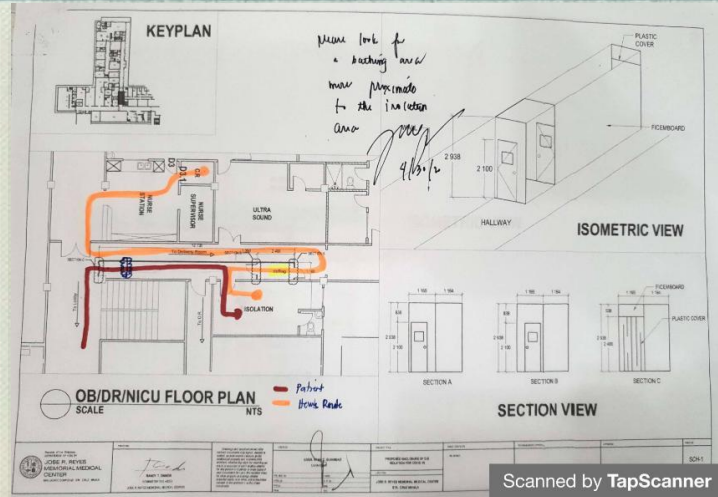


Response to COVID-19: Provision of Zoning for PPE Use

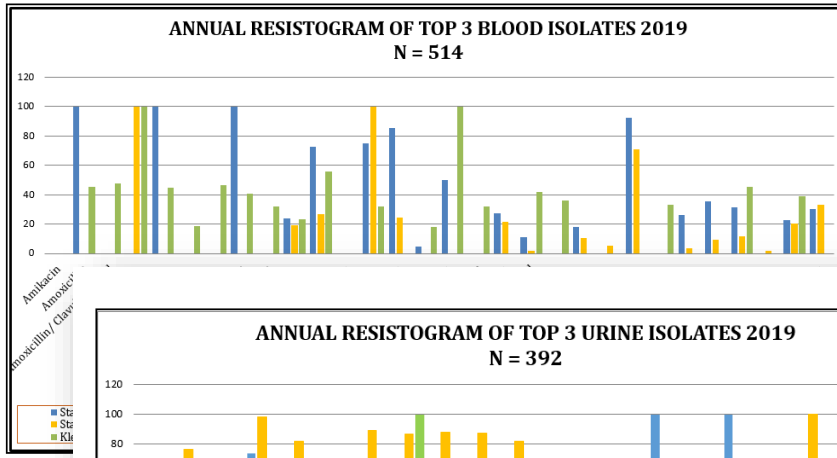

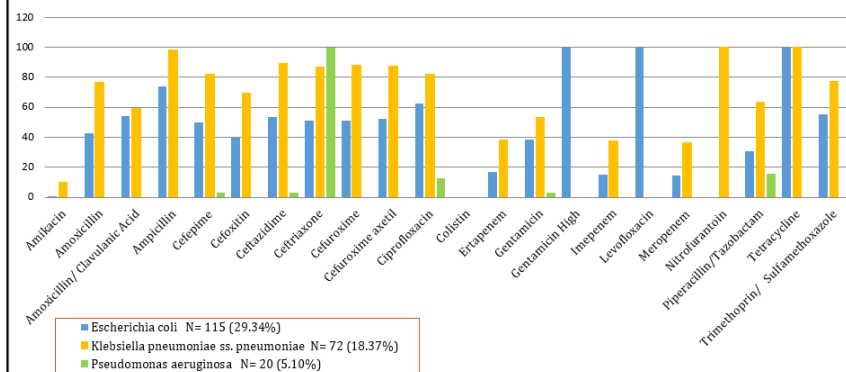

N = 514



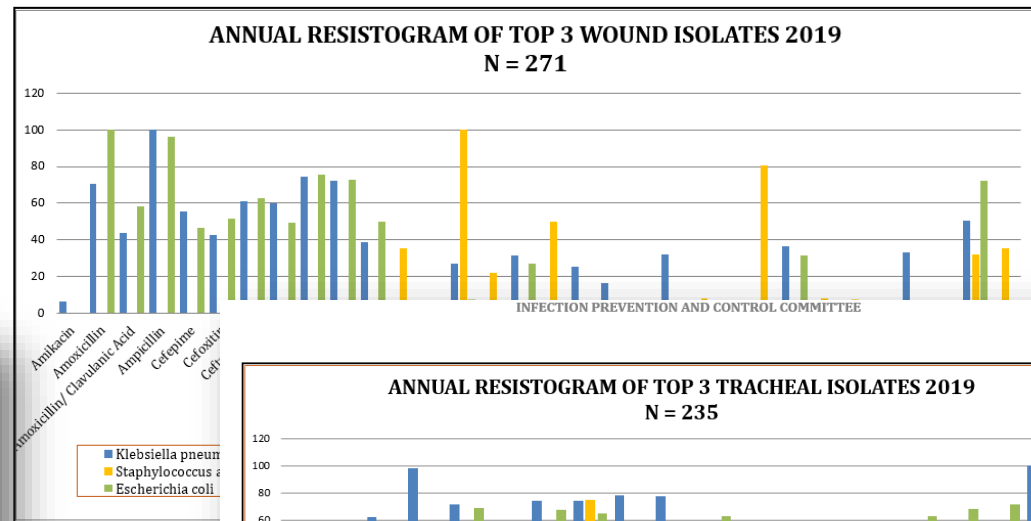
ANNUAL RESISTOGRAM OF TOP 3 URINE ISOLATES 2019
N = 392



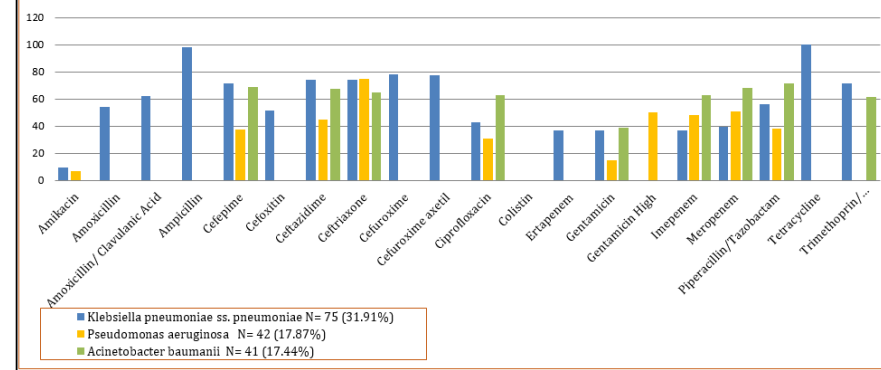
